



DAVID LUCAS BIOGRAPHY

David Lucas is Executive Director of the Maurice Lucas Foundation, which he helped start in October 2010. In that role, he is responsible for developing strategies for growth, board development, controlling the direction of the foundation, human resources and staff management, fundraising and financial management, as well as acquiring and maintaining relationships with supporters and sponsors of the foundation.

Mr. Lucas also founded All in One Basketball in July 2009 and served as Program Director of what became one of the largest and most influential youth basketball organizations in the Pacific Northwest. He interacted daily with hundreds of athletes, as well as parents, community leaders, teachers, vendors and corporate executives. He also recruited, trained and managed a staff of 20+ coaches.

Mr. Lucas earned an athletic scholarship to Oregon State University where he played on its basketball team. He was named the Pac 10 Conference's Most Improved Player in 2003 and the All-Pac 10 Conference Team in 2004 and 2005. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in psychology, sociology and communications.

In his early career, Mr. Lucas played professional basketball in Portugal, China and Poland. He has a passion for fostering development opportunities for students in the foundation's Academy program.

In June 2018 the Portland Business Journal recognized Mr. Lucas as one of the top 40 business leaders in Portland under the age of 40.

In addition to leading the Maurice Lucas Foundation, he currently serves on the Portland Trail Blazers Foundation's Board of Professionals and the Providence Milwaukie Foundation Board. He also received the 2020 Liberty & Hope Award from the League of Minority Voters. David resides in Lake Oswego.
