

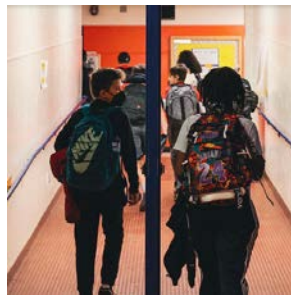
SUMMER NEWSLETTER

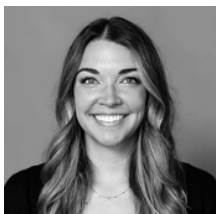
